Notes:

- This plan supposes a 44 credit liberal arts/sciences major (11 courses). For majors with more or fewer courses, there will need to be adjustments to the course load expectations (more or fewer electives, for example).
- For liberal arts majors in the School of Arts and Humanities (i.e. English, History, Modern Languages), students must complete one semester of a Modern Language (this will count as an ISP requirement).
- Students and Advisors should consult the updated list of liberal arts/sciences majors that are considered acceptable to take with an Education major, Secondary option. Additionally, there may be specific requirements in that discipline for Education majors (not required for those not seeking certification in that liberal arts/sciences discipline).
